Grading Policy

Group	Weight	Description
Student Agency (Attendance)	1%	Each day students will receive 1 point for coming to class on time.
Opening Activity (Bell ringer)	9%	Warm up activities.
Student Activity (Class Work)	25%	Includes assignments, group work, and “checks” that show students’ progress towards summative assessments. There will be a minimum of 20 classwork assignments.
Formative Assessments	25%	Includes any assignment where students demonstrate mastery of a learning standard including formative assessments/quizzes. There will be a minimum of 5-7 formative assessments over the course of a block.
Summative Assessments	40%	Includes 2-4 progressive tests and the course post-test.
Total	100%	Not to exceed. Gradebooks will be audited by administration periodically throughout the block.

Attendance and Make-up Work

If you are absent, you are responsible to obtain and turn missing assignment(s). There will be two version for every quiz, if student were absent on the quiz day, he/she can take the second version.

Late Work: Assignments are expected to be turned on the due date for full credit. Each day the assignment is late, 10% will be taken off each day. The maximum score for overdue assignment is 60%. Students have until the unit tests to turn in late assignments. All assignments must be turned in on the last Thursday of the block.

Assessment Retakes: Students are allowed to retake quizzes **ONE** time. In order to retake a quiz, you must complete a quiz correction form and turn it along with missing work. First high score or average of the two quizzes.
